PLANTATION DRIVE



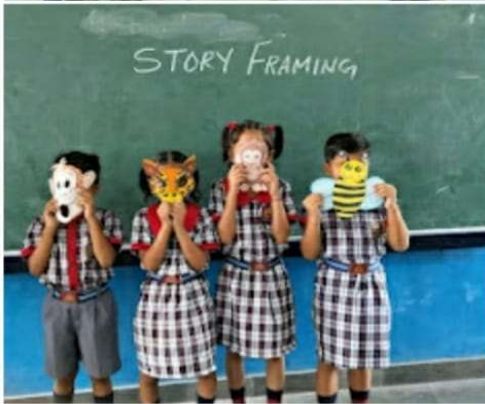

RAKSHA BANDHAN



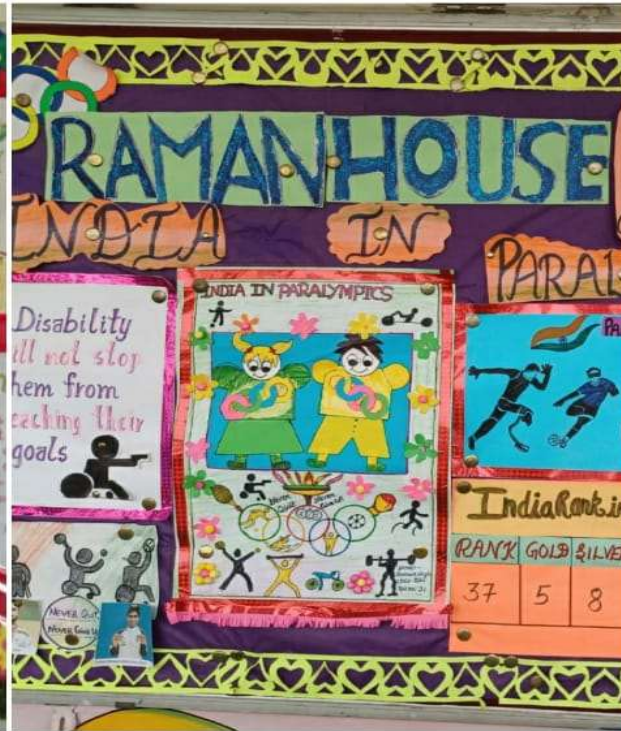

HOUSE DISPLAY BOARDS



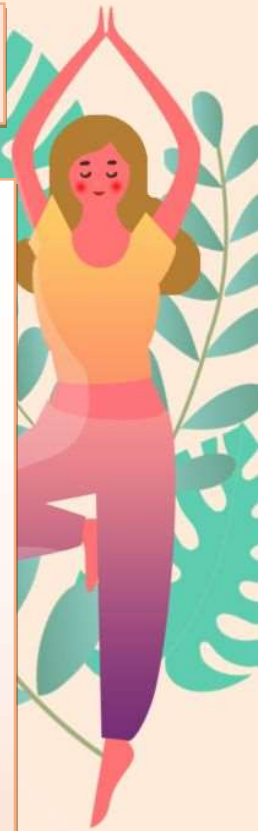
